MEXICO OPEN AT VIDANTA

The Mexico Open at Vidanta originates from the Mexican Golf Open, which dates back to 1944 and is considered the most traditional tournament in Mexico.

The 2022 edition will appear on the PGA TOUR schedule for the first time as an official FedExCup event, offering 500 FedExCup points to the winner and a purse of \$7.3 million dollars, which will be played from April 25 to May 1, 2022. at Vidanta Vallarta. The 144 player field had 12 exemptions, with at least four players from Latin America.

Since 2017, Grupo Salinas has been committed to bringing the best golf to Mexico and today this sport is stronger than ever. Starting in 2022, the Mexico Open at Vidanta will continue Grupo Salinas' commitment to bring golf closer to all Mexicans, particularly young people.

The avant-garde of the PGA TOUR will merge with the history of professional golf in Mexico in the form of the Mexico Open at Vidanta, a worldclass tournament that will be a true showcase and platform for more Mexican players.

Mexico Open at Vidanta is a long-term project between Grupo Salinas and PGA TOUR to grow golf in our country. The tournament has wide international coverage as it is broadcast in 221 countries and territories around the world and has a reach of 900 million people.

In addition to the sports show, the Mexico Open at Vidanta offers a great gastronomic and social experience that no one wants to miss, improving year after year the expectations of our attendees.



Failure to comply with these regulations may leave you outside the Volunteer Team and prevent you from participating in future tournaments.

So you must respect each of the following points:

1-All volunteers must work a minimum of 3 days. If you have any unforeseen or emergency that does not allow you to fulfill your commitment as a volunteer, it is important that you inform your Captain as soon as possible to ensure that your absence does not affect the operation of the tournament.

2-Volunteer badges are NON TRANSFERABLE. They are for personal use and access only.

3-Family members and friends are not allowed with the volunteers during their working hours.

4-Volunteers working in Hospitalities or The Clubhouse are not allowed to bring family members or friends inside this premises.

5-Access to restricted areas is prohibited.

6-Alcoholic beverages are prohibited during working hours.

7-After working hours, drinking alcohol is permitted please do not wear the uniform and badge.

8-By international law, it is forbidden to smoke inside closed areas. Smoking is permitted away from the public, children, competing players and television cameras.

9-Autographs and photographs are prohibited during your volunteer working hours. Please do not use your volunteer position as an excuse to request autographs or photographs.

10-Volunteers under 18 years old, should send their Chairmen a responsive letter that we will provide, filled and signed by their parent or legal guardian. Otherwise, they cannot be part of our team.

Trainings

All volunteers will receive a brief orientation of their duties from their Captain/Chairperson at the start of their first shift.

All volunteers must present themselves at the general entrance with a valid ID for the training. During tournament week it is mandatory the use of a valid accreditation badge. THIS WILL ENABLE YOU TO ENTER THE EVENT.

Distribution of uniforms and badges

Uniforms and badges will be distributed on Saturday, April 23rd or Sunday, April 24th from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm at Volunteer Headquarters (VHQ). Please park at the main Mexico Open by Vidanta Parking lot, your name will be on a list and you will have to show a valid ID.

If you, by any reason could not pick up the uniform kit and badge on the dates previously mentioned then you must show up at the general entrance of the event with a valid ID in order to getr access.

Please notify your captain in order to facilitate your access.

Your badge is UNIQUE AND NON TRANSFERABLE. It is only for personal use. Its misuse will cause you to be expelled from the event.

This badge identifies you as a volunteer so it is an obligation to wear it at all times.



Volunteer Kit & Uniform

Your volunteer kit includes:

- 2 Adidas Polo Shirt Green
- 1 Adidas Pullover Green
- 1 hat
- 1 Pin
- 1 Back pack

This year you can buy a third polo shirt for \$400 pesos. Only debit, credit or cashless.

Please wear your volunteer shirt with, a grey color pant, skirt, skort or golf shorts along with confortable shoes.

Keep in mind that using only your uniform will not give you access to the tournament. You will also need to use your badge somewhere visible.

Upon arriving at the volunteer tent, you should go to the Check-In area where you will receive the uniform kit and your MyCashless bracelet when you register. It is important that you **do not take off this bracelet** because we can only deliver one for the entire week of the tournament.



The oficial parking of the Mexico Open at Vidanta is:

Parking of Mexico Open at Vidanta Location: Main entrance of the tournament. Rate: No cost for the volunteers Use your volunteer badgeas identification.



Volunteer Headquarters (VHQ)

Access the golf course through the main entrance using your volunteer badge. The volunteer headquarters (VHQ) is located

500 mts after the main entrance at the left side of hole 8 fairway.

Once you are in the golf course you will follow the main road, next to it you will find the Official Merchandising Shop of the tournament, then continue walking until you find the volunteer tent to your left. The VHQ is where all volunteers check in for their shifts, eat and can spend their spare time. There you will find the following:

• Breakfast

• Snacks

- Unlimited drinks
- Electrical outlets
- O Televisions with live tournament broadcast
- O Restrooms
- Terrace

• Shop official merchandising of the Mexico Open at Vidanta.

This area is exclusively for volunteers, access to family, friends and spectators is not permitted.



Shifts & Registration

REGISTRATION will be linked to your meal, we recommend you read this section carefully. Any questions can be solved by your Captain.

On your first day of work, (or on the day of the delivery of uniforms) before your shift begins, you will be given a MyCashless bracelet. You cannot take it off until the tournament is over. This will be your one and **ONLY** tool for food, check-in, and check-out.

CHECK IN

You must cehck in every day at the entrance of the Volunteer Tent. Your wristband is scanned by registering at the beginning of each shift.

ADD CREDIT

Once your check-in is done, go to the LOAD MONEY location in the volunteer tent, where your MyCashless bracelet will be loaded with an amount to purchase the volunteer food combo for the day at the available concessions.

IMPORTANT If you do not scan your bracelet each day, the amount you have been assigned for food will not be loaded for the day. The amounts allocated daily are not cumulative and they are not applicable for snacks, drinks or dessert.





BREAKFAST

Every morning when you check in the Volunteer Tent, you will be given a voucher so you can receive your breakfast. This will be served by catering of Chef Elias Sapien. These foods can be consumed daily and are not part of the daily budget you have for lunch / lunch / box lunch.

MEALS

In the afternoon you can also enjoy a wide variety of dishes in the volunteer tent.

The schedules: Breakfast 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Lunch 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Note: Please consider that breakfast time is not part of your shift, so you must arrive early enough to enjoy your meals without affecting your schedule.

Concessions Information

As mentioned above every day when you check in and recharge your bracelet with credit, you can use it in the assigned concessions

(CHECK COMBOS AVAILABLE IN YOUR VOLUNTEER TENT)

Remember that you have access to unlimited drinks at the volunteer tent at all times.

What happens if I can't move from my work area to get food?

Notify your Captain to assist you with food distribution.

Can I put extra money on my bracelet to buy food that is not in the combos?

In any MyCashless you can add money with either cash or credit card.

Note: Remember alcoholic beverages are not allowed during your shift hours, so you won't be able to buy them with your volunteer bracelet.

In case you want to drink a beer, we remind you that by regulation f the tournament you must do it without the uniform and badge. You must request another MyCashless bracelet and add balance.



Volunteer Orientation

A fundamental part of your volunteer duty is tobe able to work a minimum of 3 days.

It is important to consider transportation times from the parking lot to the volunteer tent, time for your meal and getting to your point of work. It is very important to be on time to your duties.

Inside of the course we have two transportation routes making stops so you can easily walk to your work station, get to know this points so you make the right stop.

Public Parking

All spectators will have access to the parking lot at the Mexico Open at Vidanta This will cost:

\$200.00 pesos per day. Cash only.

Public acces hours are:

Doors: 08:00 am to 06:30 pm

Hospitalities: 09:00 am to 06:30 pm

Merchandising: 09:00 am to 07:00 pm



Children under 12 years of age admission

Children under 12 years of age are welcome to come at the general areas of the tournament free of charge, if they come accompanied by an adult who has any type of tournament ticket.

(One child per adult ticket)

In the case of admission to Hospitalities, children from 3 to 12 years old DO require a ticket.

Mobile Devices Policies

Tickets will be available at Will Call for pick up, in the ticket office next to the parking lot from April 28 to May 1 starting at 8:00 am.



Tickets

All guests entering the event must have an accreditation or ticket (either general or Hospitality) so they can have access to the event.

General tickets allow the guest to be in any common area just like Hospitality tickets.

However, the latter being exclusive, Hospitality tickets have access to the suite that corresponds to their ticket.



Hospitalities

On the course there are Hospitality areas that have unlimited drinks and food, Wifi, television with live broadcast, waiter service and other amenities that allow the spectators have a better experience. The Hospitality area is in Hole 18.

Open from Thursday, April 28th through Sunday, May 1st. From 9:00 am to 6:30 pm.

Remember **children under 2 years old** do not need accreditation for Hospitalities.



Bleachers

We have bleachers that are open to the public located at:

- O Hole 1
- O Hole 11



MyCashless

This is a payment system that improves the shopping experience of those attending mass events. This is operated through a bracelet with a chip that is recharged with different payment methods.

This system works as follows:

- O Go to a MyCashless recharge module.
- Get your bracelet.
- Recharge the amount you want, whether in cash, credit card and / or debit card.
- Pay for your food, drinks and / or items from the official store.
- O Enjoy.

There is also the Aligator Bar (H18) with different beverage options including beer, wine and long drinks.

In addition to the gastronomic experience, it is a space to enjoy the event with umbrellas, armchairs, picnic tables, screens with live broadcast, and more.

The hours of operation are: Wednesday to Sunday from 9:00 am to 6:30 pm.



It's in the Fan Zone Palmeras. It has a 3-hour access per child. Includes an activity, a drink and a snack.

Fan Shop

This is the official store of the tournament. It is located near Hole 3 where different brands such as Under Armor, Blackquail and Black Clover are offered, among others.

Here you can find jackets, sweatshirts, polo shirts, tshirts, caps, and golf accessories such as tees, ballmarkers, jacknifes, divots, and souvenirs such as key chains, flags, pins, cups, jars, piggy banks and stuffed animals. Don't miss the opportunity to visit it during the tournament.

Credit, debit, American Express, MyCashless and cash cards are accepted.

Honorary Observers

Walking inside the ropes is an experience with the players. Honorary observers who receive this invitation must arrive at the Honorary Observers tent located at Hole 1 or hole 10 to register, receive their uniform, confirm their group and departure time.



Media Center

Media from all over the world will be in Mexico to cover the Mexico Open at Vidanta so there is a special area for them back of the Hospitality.

It has a live broadcast of the event, a dining room and a interview room. You must have an authorized credential to access this area.

Covid Information

Due to security measures and protocols imposed by the government, all volunteers must present their complete vaccination card.

The use of mask will be mandatory.



In Case Of Emergency

1. Observe the situation (check the level of danger).

2. Identify the exact location of the emergency.

3. Contact the nearest security personnel or Marshal and have a radio.

4. Remain in the area until emergency personnel arrive.

If the emergency compromises the wellbeing of the injured person, do not move it, wait for a trained person to arrive.

Security

The tournament has security personnel at all times.

If you have a problem or situation that compromises the safety of any player, spectator or volunteer, contact any person on the tournament organizing committee or volunteer with radio so they can establish communication with the necessary people.



Wheather Conditions

The PGA TOUR has an alert program in case of any storm or weather change that threatens the logistics and operation of the tournament.

If this happens, the tournament organizing committee will communicate the proper the steps to follow.

Weather Information For Spectators



It is important to be aware of the "Weather Warning" that will be published by the PGA TOUR on electronic screens located around the field. In case of an alert, viewers are advised to follow the regulations and seek refuge as soon as possible.

Avoid being near:

- Tall trees
- O Bleachers
- Golf cars
- Metal structures



Course Evacuation Plan

In the event of severe weather or any other emergency condition that requires a suspension of play or evacuation of the golf course, the following procedures will be in effect from Monday the 25th of April 2022 until the conclusion of the tournament.

Primary concerns:

The primary concern of this plan is the evacuation of the professional players, caddies, and possibly player families, in the event of a suspension of play. It does not include standard bearers or scorers. Also inform spectators and other volunteers as to areas of shelter available during the suspension of play.

Secondary concerns:

As well as transporting the above to safety, the message of inclement weather must be communicated to the general spectators.

As soon as weather is identified as being a potential threat, the PGA TOUR will issue a 'Weather Warning'. This weather warning will be broadcast over the scoreboards located on site, as well as being communicated via staff, volunteers and law enforcement agencies.

At this point, all parties involved in the process will have been notified. The spectators will be advised to vacate the grounds via their point of entry, to safer locations. Marshals will communicate to the spectators to leave the area and site.

The suspension of play, and therefore execution of evacuation plan, can only be issued by the PGA TOUR Rules officials. Immediately before declaring a suspension of play or course evacuation, the PGA TOUR will inform the Mexico Open at Vidanta staff, police and committee chairmen as necessary.

- Wear comfortable shoes (for example: tennis).
- O Do not wear sandals or heels.

Code Of Conduct

Below you can find basic points within a golf tournament that you should consider at all times:

- Stay out of ropes and follow the regulations established by the Marshals.
- Do not ask for autographs
- Do not move or make noise while the player throws or until the last player in the group throws.
- You must walk, never run.
- Throw trash and cigarette butts in the right place.
- To smoke you must do it away from the public, children, competing players and television cameras.
